## Delegate Brooke Lierman's Scholarship Application

*Please read the following directions prior to filling out the application. Once you complete the application, print it and email it with the rest of your materials.*

### Who is Eligible:

- ✓ Only students who *currently* live in the 46th District of Maryland are eligible to apply. Look up where you live by entering your address here: [mdelect.net](http://mdelect.net).
- ✓ Only students who plan to attend a Maryland college or university or a private career school are eligible. Private career schools must have the Maryland Higher Education Commission's approval to operate and must be accredited by a national accrediting association approved by the U.S. Department of Education. You may also attend a nursing school if the Commission approves the curriculum.
- ✓ Part-time or full-time students are eligible.
- ✓ Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible; however, *preference is given to undergraduate students.*
- ✓ You may use this scholarship at an out-of-state school if your major is not available at a Maryland school. The Office of Student Financial Assistance must verify your major is unique. Please call 410-767-3155 for more information.
- ✓ Returning applicants (i.e. second/third year applicants) will generally receive no more than \$500.

### How to Apply:

1. Complete the written application questionnaire below
2. Attach your letter of recommendation, short answer responses, a copy of your FAFSA Student Aid Report (or its equivalent) and a sealed copy of your official transcript.
3. Send your COMPLETE application to Delegate Lierman's office by May 1, 2020. It must be postmarked no later than May 1 to be considered.
